At Old City Hall, LAO has a staff lawyer who can represent or give legal advice to homeless clients facing "nuisance charges" (i.e. panhandling, public intoxication) in Provincial Offences Court. Make sure you call ahead to make an appointment. Services are available every Thursday from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

At Sound Times Support Services, LAO partners with a community mental health agency to help clients managing mental health and addictions disabilities and who are living on the street with legal problems. Appointments are mainly by appointment, but there are drop-in hours on Mondays and Wednesdays from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m.
